The Chairman of IQAC Dr.N. Jayakumar, Principal extended his warm welcome to all the members and informed the house that the AQAR for the year 2015-16 is ready for submission to the college committee and he registered his acknowledgement to all the members for their sincere efforts in the preparation process of AQAR.

#### I. Plan of Action for 2017-18

The IQAC Co-Ordinator Prof. B. Mahalingam submitted the following **Plan of Action for 2017-18** and it was approved unanimously.

- a. Considering the huge demand for research in English and the faculty of English have guide recognition from Bharathiar University to guide Ph.D scholars, it is planned to start Ph.D part time programme in English.
- b. To promote awareness among the faculty members about the Outcome Based Education, it is decided to organize a seminar related to this topic by IQAC.
- c. Due to increase in demand from the students for transport, it is proposed to purchase a new bus.

- d. To curb ragging in college campus, to maintain student discipline and for the purpose of safety and security, it is planned to install CCTV cameras at the important points.
- e. The department of Zoology is specialized in Molecular Biology Research. Hence it is planned to establish a well equipped Molecular Biology Research Laboratory.
- f. To enhance the ICT enabled teaching and learning process in the class room, it is planned to make our campus with Wi-Fi facility.
- g. To utilize and make use of renewable energy resources it is planned to install solar power plant in the premises.
- h. To improve the hygienic conditions and to give a modern look, it is planned to lay ceramic tiles for floors and side walls in all the existing rest rooms in the college premises.
- i. To cater to additional demand of the water of our institutions it is proposed to dig a bore well in the college.
- j. To increase job opportunities to the students, it is planned to organize job fairs and career guidance programme.
- k. To continue the Merit Scholarship scheme & Bharathiar University poor students free education scheme for this academic year.
- 1. To acquire more knowledge in Recent Trends and Developments in different fields, it is proposed to organize conferences and symposium.
- m. To enhance the capability of acquiring more knowledge by the students, it is decided to continue offering Add-on courses.
- n. To encourage and create more awareness on social responsibility among the students, it is planned to organize many programmes which requires social participation of students.
- o. To encourage faculty members to get financial assistance for their research projects from various funding agencies through the Research forum of our college.
- p. To make our campus Eco Friendly, it is decided to take green initiation process.
- q. To motivate students participation in teaching- learning process.
- r. It is decided to organize special programs to promote awareness on self employment among the student's community.

## **MINUTES OF THE IQAC - MEETING**

On 05.04.2018, Thursday, a meeting of IQAC was held at 10.30 a.m. in the Principal's Chamber. The IQAC Chairman Dr.N. Jayakumar, Principal presided over the meeting.

The Chairman of IQAC Dr.N. Jayakumar, Principal extended his warm welcome to all the members and appreciated their co-operation in implementing the various plan of action for the year 2017-18.

### I. Submission of AQAR for 2015-16 & 2016-17

The IQAC Co-Ordinator Prof. B.Mahalingam informed the house that the AQAR for the year 2015-16 was approved by the college committee in its meeting held on 26.10.2017 and the AQAR was submitted on 08.11.2017 to NAAC.

The IQAC Co-Ordinator further informed that the AQAR for the year 2016-17 was approved by the college committee meeting held on 23.03.2018 and it is ready for submission to NAAC. The IQAC Co-Ordinator Prof. B.Mahalingam recorded his sincere gratitude to all the IQAC & Faculty members who have supported in the preparation of AQAR.

#### II. Approval for Action Taken Report 2017-18

Prof. B. Mahalingam, IQAC Co-Ordinator submitted the following **Action Taken Report for 2017-18** and it was approved.

- 1. Application was submitted to Bharathiar University to offer Ph.D in English under part time and inspection committee have visited the department and granted affiliation from the year 2018-19.
- 2. One day seminar on Outcome Based Education & Bloom's Taxonomy was organized by the IQAC for all faculty members.
- 3. A New bus for transportation of students was purchased.
- 4. With the support of financial assistance by the management, 28 Nos of CCTV Cameras at various points were installed which led to CCTV Surveillance in the campus.
- 5. A well equipped Molecular Biology Research Laboratory was established with modern equipments leading to advanced research.
- 6. Reliance Jio Wi-Fi Network coverage throughout the campus was established with the facility of free downloading of 1 GB mobile data per month for each student.
- 7. Installation of Solar on Grid Power Plant System, Poly Crystalline /315/320 WP Module, Dimension 1600mm x 947 mm, String Inverter FRONIUS 20/25 KW with a capacity of 40 KW is in progress.
- 8. In all the existing rest rooms in the college premises, the floors and side walls were laid with ceramic tiles which are funded by the management.
- 9. A bore well of 6.5 inches width with submersible motor was dedicated by the management to fulfill the additional demand of water.
- 10. The placement cell organized various programmes like Group Discussion, Resume Preparation, etc to make the students fit for the job.
- 11. The cell organized a training programme on "Resume Preparation" 85 students got benefited.
- 12.7 Phases of campus interview were conducted in which totally 17 companies participated and 360 students of our college got the offer letters
- 13. Our students secured 16 University Ranks, of which 4 are Gold Medalist in the Bharathiar University Exams.
- 14. Merit Scholarship prizes amounted Rs.2, 77,500/- were distributed by the management to 249 students.
- 15. Bharathiar University "Poor Students Free Education" 6 students admitted. Totally -16 Students got benefitted.
- 16. One International Symposium in Management and One National Conference in Computer Science were organized.

- 17. Online Courses of NPTEL IIT, Madras and Spoken Tutorial IIT, Bombay were conducted in seven different topics for improving career skills and development of the students.
- 18.28 students wrote Hindi "Prathmic" examination and all the 28 students passed with 100% results.
- 19. Swayam Prabha is the digital online platform which was installed for the benefit of students and staff members.
- 20. Blood donors club was instrumental in the conduct of three blood donation camps in which 146 units of blood donated.
- 21. Four Remedial classes, Five Computer Literacy programmes, One awareness programme on CA course and 18 objective type tests were conducted for the benefit of school students in the nearby Govt.Hr.Secondary Schools. 2200 objective type question and answer books in science and commerce subjects were distributed to nearby 52 Govt.Hr.Sec.Schools.
- 22.21 social responsibility programs were conducted at Govt.Hr.Sec.Schools of Erode & Namakkal Districts.
- 23. Three Minor Research Projects of UGC and One Research Project from Indian Academy of Sciences, one project from Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology were applied and all the above projects were approved by respective agencies with a sanctioned amount of Rs.20,68,000/- and an amount of Rs. 4,99,250/- was received in the year.
- 24. A Herbal Garden and a Flower Garden were developed by Enviro Club in the campus.
- 25. Related to students involvement in learning process the following were the various outcomes:
- 26.54 Guest lectures, 30 Workshops, 199 students Paper Presentation and 199 students Seminar, 22 volumes of Department Bulletins, 5 Study tours, 13 Industrial visits, 21 Intra Department competitions, 206 Remedial classes and 45 aptitude training programs were conducted by all the departments for the benefit of our students.
- 27. Eves cell and Entrepreneurial Training cell jointly organized sales and Exhibition of the products of 20 self help groups in the college bazaar and the sales amounted to Rs.92, 686/- in three days. 1580 students visited and got benefited.

28. A one day workshop programme on "Home Furnishings and Accessories Making" held on 05.03.2018. 54 students took active part in this Workshop and got trained. The trainers of the workshop were our own Costume Design students and the participants were immensely benefited through this workshop.

Prof. B. Mahalingam IQAC Co-Ordinator proposed vote of thanks to all the IQAC members.
